

ANNOUNCEMENT:

This event is an Advanced Level ClubSport Bent Sprint (Single Car) as described in New Zealand MotorSport Manual No. 33 or its successor. It will be held under the provisions of the National Sporting Code (NSC), Appendix 2 Schedule A and Appendix 5 Schedule C Standing Regulations Part 1.

INVITED CLUBS:

Members of any MotorSport NZ Inc. affiliated club are invited to participate; Members of Fiat Club Waikato Inc., Hamilton Car Club Inc., Minis Waikato Inc., Thames Valley Car Club Inc., and Tauranga Mount Motorsport Club Inc. will be given preference if the event is oversubscribed.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any car, Ute or station wagon that conforms to MotorSport NZ Inc Appendix Two Schedule A or AA safety standards is eligible to compete. A sample of at least 15% of entries will be selected for safety audit on the day. All vehicles that do not have a MotorSport NZ Log Book will be audited. Acceptance of any entry will be at the absolute discretion of the organisers. All competitors must be a financial member of a MotorSport NZ Inc affiliated club.

LICENCES:

A MotorSport New Zealand ClubSport or higher grade licence and a current Club membership card must be presented at documentation. If the entry is by other than the competitor then an Entrant's Licence must be presented at documentation.

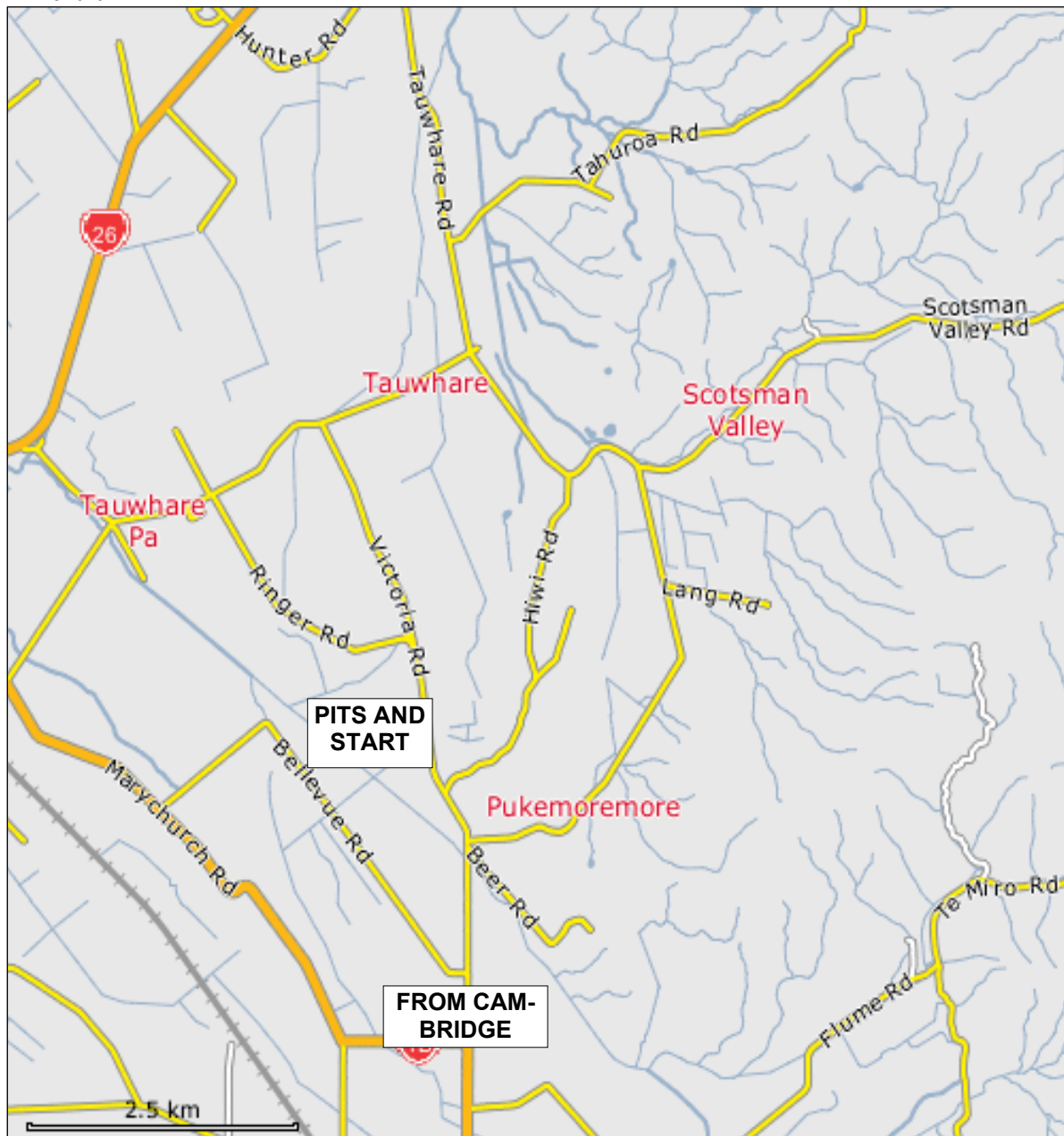

Unregistered vehicles must not be driven on the roads that are not closed for the event. When turning vehicles around at either the end of the sprint or prior to lining up to start competitors must respect other people's property. This means there are to be no wheelies in driveways or hand brake turns on the road. Competitors must also ensure that access to the Bus Depot and adjoining house are kept clear at all times.

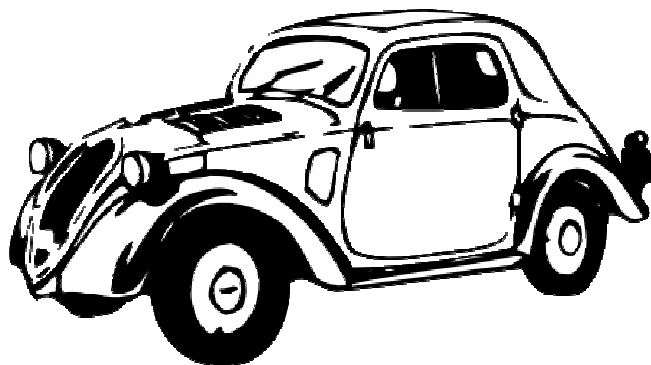

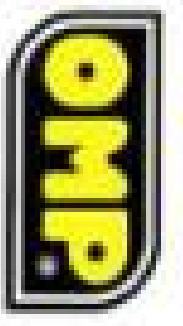

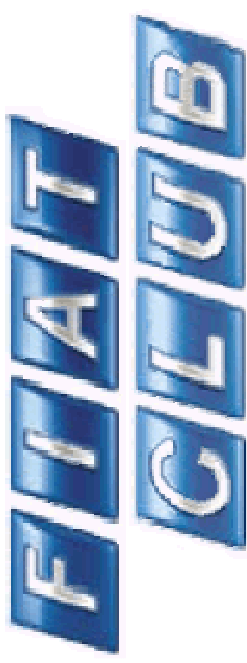
