ANNOUNCEMENT:

This meeting will be promoted by the Fiat Club Waikato Inc. under the provisions of the National Sporting Code of MotorSport New Zealand, and any relevant regulations, prescriptions or specifications pertaining thereto, and these Supplementary Regulations. The meeting will be run as a Basic Level ClubSport competition for motorkhanas. We will endeavour to run at least four courses. This event is intended to encourage newcomers to motorsport to take part.

ELIGIBILITY:

Any car, ute or station wagon that conforms to NZLTSA Warrant of Fitness safety standards is eligible to compete. Random checks on vehicle safety will be made throughout the day. Acceptance of any entry will be at the absolute discretion of the organisers. All competitors must be a financial member of a MotorSport NZ Inc affiliated club unless they are first time motorsport competitors.
